The Hansa 2.3

We have 6 of this class which are used as an introduction to sailing.

It is safe, simple and forgiving. With its one sail and joystick controls, even a person with no sailing experience can be sailing confidently in under one hour. Once competence and confidence have been gained, it is the Ideal boat to start solo sailing before moving up to the Hansa 303.

The wide side decks keep the boat dry even at extreme angles of heel. With a very low centre of gravity and having a weighted keel and a low seating arrangement, the boat is virtually uncapsizable.

The Hansa 303(W) – Paralympic Class

- We have 14 in this class the latest additions were donated by the Sun Hung Kai Scallywag Foundation in 2019.
- It is the ideal boat for a very first sail as the sailor can be accompanied by an experienced sailor and they can start in the crewing role and be trained in the use of each element of control i.e. Jib only, Mainsail only, Helm only, then combinations until she/he is controlling the whole boat. They can also be trained in the basics of racing
- The Hansa 303 is an Ideal trainer boat for sailors who want to develop towards two sail single handed sailing in this or the Hansa Liberty.

The Hansa Liberty (Single Handed)

We have 3 of this Class

Twenty percent longer than the 303 but the same width, makes the Liberty a very fast and high pointing sailing dinghy. Proficient sailors can progress to the Liberty after gaining confidence in the 303.

The high coamings and wide side decks keep the boat dry even at extreme angles of heel and the two high aspect rudder blades ensure directional stability. The Liberty has two rudders because, being a single seater and with the sailor sitting on the centreline, the boat has to be free to heel and still maintain directional stability.
